Health Information Requirements
(Due prior to the first day of school)

Austin-Travis County Health & Human Services and the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services requires St. Matthew's to have your child's current health information on file.

We need TWO pieces of information for your child's official file:

1. A current well check statement from the doctor.
The statement needs to include the doctor's letter head or official stamp and the date of the last well check. The well check summary/receipt that the doctor gives at the time of the office visit (has child's age, weight, height, etc. recorded) usually has the required information.
2. A copy of their current immunization record.
The immunization record has to have the doctor's official address stamp on it.

If you have opted not to give vaccinations at this time, the Health Department requires us to have an exemption affidavit on file. Please be sure to go online and get that document from the State of Texas. After you apply for the affidavit it takes time to be processed so please proceed with this action promptly. The official title of the document is "Affidavit Exemption from Immunizations for Reasons of Conscience".

For children ages 4, 5 and 6 we will need Vision and Hearing testing results included in their files. If you choose, those two tests can be done here on campus in the fall. Information and sign up notices will be sent home after the beginning of school.

You are welcome to simply email the information or bring it to the office. We are happy to make any copies that you may need.
